1 WHEREAS Missouri’s Hunter Education program has achieved outstanding success by reducing
 2 average annual incident rates from 100 prior to mandatory certification to 30 currently;
 3 AND WHEREAS, the state is committed to continuing and improving on this current rate of decrease
 4 in hunting incidents;
 5 AND WHEREAS, the future of hunter safety is found in the youth of our state;
 6 AND WHEREAS, the future trend of Hunter Education is found in alternative style deliveries;
 7 AND WHEREAS, alternative delivery methods are being used and accepted in other states;
 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Conservation Federation of Missouri assembled at
 9 the Lodge of Four Seasons, Lake Ozark, MO, this 26th day of February, 2006, encourages the Missouri
 10 Department of Conservation to explore the possibility of alternative Hunter Education delivery methods
 11 which will compliment the excellent program currently in place, while maintaining our present level of
 12 educational reliability.
