1 WHEREAS David Ostlund has served as the Executive Director of The Missouri Parks and  
2 Recreation Association in the state of Missouri for over 30 years, contributing to conservation,  
3 parks recreation and to the Quality of Life for thousands of citizens; and assisting communities,  
4 organizations and park and recreation professionals;

5 AND WHEREAS, The Missouri Parks and Recreation Association is one of the largest statewide  
6 CFM Affiliates having partnered with CFM for decades on many conservation and park issues of  
7 statewide significance under the leadership of David Ostlund;

8 AND WHEREAS. For more than three decades David has contributed to the important work of CFM,  
9 serving on committees, reporting at CFM Annual meetings, attending CFM events and serving as a  
10 spokesman for professionals charged with managements of hundreds of park and recreation  
11 agencies across the state of Missouri;

12 AND WHEREAS, His contributions to conservation have included legislative efforts such as  
13 personal contact with elected officials, testimony before legislative bodies and citizen involvement  
14 in the process including working on a national level with Federal officials for such programs as
