

## **Application for the Student Conservation Achievement Award**

Students who have completed three years as a member of the Conservation Federation of Missouri's (CFM) Conservation Leadership Corps (CLC) and who have completed a conservation-related college curriculum are eligible to be awarded a Student Conservation Achievement (SCA) award at the CFM annual meeting during the year the degree is earned. To be considered for the award the student must submit information requested in the following application:

Name of Conservation-Related Degree \_\_\_\_\_

Conservation-related degrees are presented through hundreds of courses in many degrees including traditional Forestry, Fisheries or Wildlife Management. Degrees in biology, agriculture, pre-law, social services, arts and sciences, engineering, business, medicine, etc. can also qualify if they have provided conservation-related courses. Students who apply for the SCA must (1) highlight below conservation-related coursework taken in their curriculum and (2) explain how their college degree qualifies as conservation-related, i.e. how the courses taken will promote their ability to participate in conservation activities in the future. Applicants must attach a list of conservation-related courses taken to complete the degree. CFM must receive proof of graduation. It is required to receive the Certificate of Completion.

- (1) List conservation-related coursework taken in the curriculum (copies of transcripts are acceptable).
- (2) Explain how the courses or curriculum are conservation-related.

Submit the application to the Conservation Federation office 728 West Main, Jefferson City, MO 65101-1559. Applications must be received by January 15, of the calendar year in which the degree will be completed.
