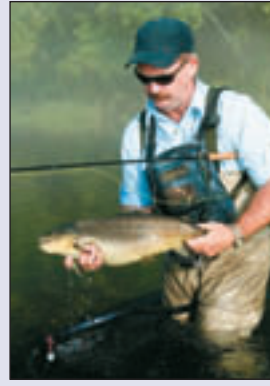

ADVOCACY

The Federation has long been a prominent and effective voice for hunting, fishing, trapping and natural resource protection. We represent our membership faithfully and serve as their voice at the Missouri General Assembly, with Congress, all Missouri and federal fish, wildlife and natural resource conservation agencies. We also speak up for sportsmen and sportswomen, outdoor users and wildlife enthusiasts all across Missouri at private and public meetings.

Since the Federation's first meeting in 1935, its members and leaders have successfully campaigned for, championed and guided to completion the state's most valuable, most crucial conservation and environmental protection laws. Most of the conservation laws in Missouri today exist because of the Federation's strong support.

OUTREACH

The Federation publishes *Missouri Wildlife* six times per year. This national award-winning magazine carries current articles, announcements and other items of interest to citizen conservationists and outdoor enthusiasts. Our website (www.confedmo.org) continues to inform our members and all Missourians about current events in conservation, natural resources, state and federal agencies and legislation. CFM is the leader in the Teaming With Wildlife movement in Missouri and actively promotes all wildlife conservation via Missouri's Comprehensive Wildlife Strategy. We provide various college scholarships and educational support to youth organizations.

At our annual convention, we host public meetings of all our natural resource committees: Archery; Camping, Hiking, Trails & Water Sports; Conservation Education & Youth Activities; Deer, Wild Turkey & Ruffed Grouse; Ecology & Environment; Fisheries & Water Resources; Forestry; Global Warming; Natural History & Wildlands; Parks; Quail & Quail Habitat; Rivers & Streams; Small Game & Furbearers; Solid Waste, Hazardous Waste & Recycling; Sportsmen's Rights & Hunter Safety; Waterfowl & Wetlands. Also at our annual convention we present awards to Conservationists of the Year in many categories.

PROGRAMS

CFM is involved in just about every major outdoors program in Missouri. We coordinate the Share The Harvest Program, the Missouri Archery in the Schools Program, Teaming With Wildlife, Operation Game Thief and Operation Forest Arson. We helped start the Missouri Stream Teams program, the KATY Trail, the Ozark Trail, the National Scenic Riverways and many, many others...and we work actively to this very day to ensure their continuation.

The Conservation Leadership Corps (CLC) is our program to develop youth as private citizen conservation leaders for the future. Hundreds of high school and college aged students are alumni of our program. They learn how to actively participate in advocacy. They learn our process of resolution development and implementation. The National Wildlife Federation has picked our CLC program as a national model for excellence.
