

Conservation Leadership Corps Application for the Student Conservation Achievement Award

Students who have completed at least two years as a member of the Conservation Federation of Missouri's (CFM) Conservation Leadership Corps **AND** who have attended at least 4 CLC events are eligible for a Student Conservation Achievement (SCA) Award. Students must also be able to show evidence of volunteer hours/experience during their time with the CLC. Awards are presented at the CFM annual meeting. Student must be in good standing within the program. Application for the award indicates that this will be the students last year in the program even if the student is not graduating. To be considered for the award the student must submit the following information:
